MCACHE's Student Activities Committee is preparing for the 12th annual Job Shadow Day scheduled for the week of January 30 - February 3, 2017. The purpose of the job shadow day is to link graduate students enrolled in Health Services Administration programs at Eastern Michigan University, Oakland University, Siena Heights University, the University of Detroit Mercy, the University of Michigan and the University of Toledo to Health Care Executives in Southeast Michigan and Northwestern Ohio for a day of observation.

The job shadow day will:

- Raise awareness of MCACHE and ACHE among health care professionals, universities, students and the general public.
- Raise awareness of health care systems and health care careers.
- Raise awareness among health care systems of a wider pool of job candidates.
- Increase membership in MCACHE and ACHE.
